I would like to give you an introduction to the Pocatello Regional Family History Center. The center is located at 156 ½ South 6th Ave in Pocatello Idaho. The center is open Monday, Friday, and Saturday 9am to 5pm Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday 9am to 9pm.

As the public comes to the center they find 26 computers with internet access ready to be used by the public for research, a computer lab which is used for public classes and other types of training. Two scanners one which will scan legal and letter size pages, negatives, and slides the second which will scan microfilm, and microfiche. The center also has a classroom that is used for lectures, and staff meeting.

For helping the public research family lines the center has a number of subscription online databases that are free for the public to use at the center these include Ancestry.com, Footenote.com, Heritagequestonline, Worldvitalrecords.com, Swedish records, American Experiences for the civil war, Godfrey Memorial library, New England Historical and Genealogical Society databases. The center also has a large collection of family-treemakers cds that have a great deal of information. Going along with the databases on the computer the center also has a sizeable book collection that is cataloged and searchable on any of the public computer in the center. The Records of the Family History Library in Salt Lake City can also be order for use locally at the center.

It has never been a better time to start researching your family lines, take the time to visit the Pocatello Regional Family History Center.
